Sessions will include paper presentations, paper discussions, demonstration sessions, invited speakers, symposia, and panel discussions. Presentations are selected through a peer review process. Graduate students who have papers selected for presentation are eligible to apply for a small travel stipend.

To submit a proposal to the Music Education SIG, presenters must be members of AERA and the Music Education SIG. The submission system opens on June 1, 2009 and proposals are due July 15, 2009. Guidelines for submission are published in the May issue of the *Educational Researcher* and are posted on the AERA Web Site (<http://www.aera.net>).
